HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3002

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study issues related to 2 restitution for criminal acts. 3 WHEREAS, courts frequently order restitution for damages resulting from the commission 4 of a criminal act and condition an offender's probation upon the payment of the restitution; and 5 WHEREAS, because of an offender's unwillingness or inability to comply with the conditions 6 of probation relating to payment of restitution, a court may terminate the offender's probation or 7 extend the term of probation for up to five additional years; and 8 WHEREAS, the number of offenders on probation in the state exceeds 5,000, which 9 represents an increase of approximately 160 percent over the last two decades; and 10 WHEREAS, supervision of offenders on probation is resource-intensive and supervision of 11 nonviolent offenders on probation for failure to fulfill conditions of restitution orders diverts 12 correctional resources from more intensive supervision of more dangerous offenders; 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 14 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 15 That the Legislative Management study issues related to restitution for criminal acts; and 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and 17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 18 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
