1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study issues related to
2 authorizing and issuing digital driver's licenses.

3 **WHEREAS**, individuals in this state are increasingly using new technologies, including
4 smartphones, in their daily lives; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the use and convenience of technological devices has become increasingly
6 more common for day-to-day functions, such as working, banking, and shopping; and

7 **WHEREAS**, there are financial and environmental costs associated with the production of
8 plastic driver's licenses; and

9 **WHEREAS**, technological advances allow for secure digital driver's licenses; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the option of issuance of digital driver's licenses has been authorized in other
11 states and should be considered for this state;

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
13 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

14 That the Legislative Management study issues related to authorizing and issuing digital
15 driver's licenses; and

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
18 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
