- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the agriculture
- 2 commissioner; to amend and reenact section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the salary of the agriculture commissioner; and to provide for transfers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

- of the sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
- beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

26 SECTION 3. TRANSFER - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND -

MINOR USE PESTICIDE FUND. The agriculture commissioner shall transfer \$325,000 from the environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION

FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of

1	\$6,464,295\$6,414,476, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and
2	rangeland protection fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department of
3	agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
4	SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND. The estimated income line
5	item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$499,585, or so much of the sum as may be
6	necessary, from the game and fish department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the
7	expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1,
8	2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
9	SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE WATER COMMISSION - TRANSFER. The
10	estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000 which the state
11	water commission shall transfer to the agriculture commissioner for the wildlife services
12	program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
13	SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended
14	and reenacted as follows:
15	4-01-21. Salary of agriculture commissioner.
16	The annual salary of the agriculture commissioner is ninety-nine thousand four hundred
17	thirty-five dollars through June 30, 2014, and one hundred two thousand four hundred
18	eighteenone hundred six thousand five hundred fifteenfive thousand four hundred ninety-one
19	dollars through June 30, 2016, and one hundred ten thousand seven hundred seventy-five eight
20	thousand six hundred fifty-six dollars thereafter.
