1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of the state's health care
2 delivery system.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - HEALTH CARE DELIVERY**

5 **SYSTEM.** During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider continuing its
6 ongoing study of the needs and challenges of the North Dakota health care delivery system.
7 The study may include monitoring the implementation of the federal Affordable Care Act,
8 examining medicaid expansion and medicaid reform, and considering the feasibility of
9 developing a state-based plan for a health care model that will comply with federal health care
10 reform in a manner that will provide high-quality access and affordable care for North Dakota
11 citizens. The university of North Dakota school of medicine and health sciences advisory council
12 shall make periodic reports to the legislative management on the status of the biennial report
13 developed pursuant to section 15-52-04. The legislative management shall report its findings
14 and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
15 recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly.
