1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 14 of section 10-04-05, subsection 14 of
2 section 10-04-06, subdivision b of subsection 12 of section 15-39.1-04, subdivision a of
3 subsection 1 of section 15-39.1-05.1, subsection 3 of section 15.1-01-01, subdivision e of
4 subsection 2 of section 15.1-02-21, subdivision b of subsection 5 of section 15.1-06-18, and
5 section 15.1-32-23 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to updating statutory references
6 to the North Dakota education association.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 14 of section 10-04-05 of the North Dakota
9 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

10 14. Securities issued by ~~the North Dakota education association~~united, or its successor
11 organization, dues credit trust to members of ~~the North Dakota education~~
12 ~~association~~united, or its successor organization.

13 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 14 of section 10-04-06 of the North Dakota
14 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15 14. The offer or sale of a security issued by ~~the North Dakota education association~~united,
16 or its successor organization, dues credit trust to members of the North Dakota
17 ~~education association~~united, or its successor organization.

18 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision b of subsection 12 of section 15-39.1-04 of the
19 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

20 b. The superintendent of public instruction, assistant superintendents of public
21 instruction, county superintendents, assistant superintendents, supervisors of
22 instruction, the professional staff of the department of career and technical
23 education, the professional staff of the center for distance education, the
24 executive director and professional staff of ~~the North Dakota education~~

1 ~~association~~united, or its successor organization, who are members of the fund on
2 July 1, 1995, the professional staff of an interim school district, and the
3 professional staff of the North Dakota high school activities association who are
4 members of the fund on July 1, 1995.

5 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 15-39.1-05.1 of the
6 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 a. The governor shall appoint, from a list of three nominees submitted to the
8 governor by ~~the North Dakota education association~~united, or its successor
9 organization, two board members who are actively employed in full-time positions
10 not classified as school administrators. A board member appointed under this
11 subdivision who terminates employment may not continue to serve as a member
12 of the board.

13 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 15.1-01-01 of the North Dakota
14 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15 3. The governor shall appoint new board members from a list of names submitted by a
16 committee consisting of the president of ~~the North Dakota education~~
17 ~~association~~united, or its successor organization, the president of the North Dakota
18 council of educational leaders, and the president of the North Dakota school boards
19 association. Two of the state board members must be members of the North Dakota
20 school boards association.

21 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision e of subsection 2 of section 15.1-02-21 of the
22 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

23 e. A representative of the North Dakota ~~education association~~united, or its
24 successor organization;

25 **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision b of subsection 5 of section 15.1-06-18 of the
26 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

27 b. Two individuals selected by the governor from a list of five nominees proposed by
28 ~~the North Dakota education association~~united, or its successor organization.

29 **SECTION 8. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-32-23 of the North Dakota Century Code is
30 amended and reenacted as follows:

1 **15.1-32-23. Special education teachers - Credentialing process.**

2 The superintendent of public instruction may not change the credentialing process for
3 special education teachers as it is in effect on July 1, 2001, without first convening a meeting to
4 include representatives of the North Dakota council of education leaders, the council of
5 exceptional children, ~~the North Dakota education association~~united, or its successor
6 organization, and the North Dakota school boards association. The purpose of the meeting is to
7 receive comments regarding the proposed changes, the applicability of the proposed changes,
8 including the scheduling, the manner of implementation, associated costs, and the short-term
9 and long-term effects of the proposed changes. If, within thirty days after the date of the
10 meeting, members of any two representative groups present at the meeting object in writing to
11 the proposed changes, the superintendent may not implement the proposed changes before
12 July 1, 2003.

NOTE: There also exists a reference to "North Dakota Education Association" in Article VIII, Section 6, of the Constitution of North Dakota. However, amendments to the state constitution cannot be achieved through legislative bill drafts.
