1 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** House Rule 206 is amended as follows:
 2 **206. Officers and employee positions of the House.** The following officers and employee
 3 positions are established, with the number, title, and manner of selection for each position as

 17 party's percentage of the total number of the members-elect and each party shall appoint the
 18 persons to the positions allocated to them, acting by and through the Employment Committee.
 19 The majority party has the first right to select positions of a group until its allocation is filled.

20 The powers, duties, and qualifications for each officer or employee are as provided by law,
 21 these rules, and the current Legislative Session Employee Handbook.

22 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Senate Rule 206 is amended as follows:

 24 employee positions are established, with the number, title, and manner of selection for each

9 persons to the positions allocated to them, acting by and through the Employment Committee.
10 The majority party has the first right to select positions of a group until its allocation is filled.
