1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to qualifications for licensure as an electrician.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **43-09-11. Qualifications.**

7 1. An applicant for an electrician's license must have the following experience and
8 training:

9 ~~1.~~ a. For licensure as a master electrician, an applicant must have completed one
10 year's experience as a licensed journeyman electrician.

11 ~~2.~~ b. For licensure as a journeyman electrician, an applicant must have:

12 ~~a.~~ (1) Completed eight thousand hours' experience in installing and repairing
13 electrical wiring, apparatus, and equipment, which experience may not be
14 obtained in less than three years.

15 ~~b.~~ (2) Effective for an applicant who registered with the board as an apprentice
16 after January 31, 2008, completed at least one of the following:

17 ~~(1)~~ (a) Successfully completed apprenticeship training approved by the
18 federal bureau of apprenticeship and training and completed eight
19 thousand hours' experience in installing and repairing electrical wiring,
20 apparatus, and equipment.

21 ~~(2)~~ (b) Successfully completed an appropriate course of study, which may not
22 be less than two years or the equivalent of two years, at a
23 board-approved institution of higher education and completed eight
24 thousand hours' experience in installing and repairing electrical wiring,
