1 A BILL ~~for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 5-01-01 of the North Dakota~~  
2 ~~Century Code, relating to the definition of alcohol.~~ for an Act to create and enact section 5-01-22  
3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the prohibition of powdered alcohol products.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 ~~SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.~~ ~~Subsection 2 of section 5-01-01 of the North Dakota Century~~

7 ~~\_\_\_\_\_ 2. "Alcoholic beverages" means any liquid substance suitable for drinking ingestion by~~  
8 ~~human beings, which contains one-half of one percent or more of alcohol by volume.~~

9 SECTION 1. Section 5-01-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as  
10 follows:

11 5-01-22. Powdered alcohol products prohibited - Penalty - Exceptions.

- 12 1. As used in this section, "powdered alcohol product" means any alcohol prepared or
- 13 sold in a powder form for either direct use or reconstitution in a liquid beverage or
- 14 food.
- 15 2. A person may not sell, offer to sell, purchase, offer to purchase, possess, or consume
- 16 a powdered alcohol product.
- 17 3. A violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor.
- 18 4. This section does not apply to the use of powdered alcohol products for research by a:
  - 19 a. Health care provider that operates primarily for the purpose of conducting
  - 20 scientific research;
  - 21 b. State institution;
  - 22 c. Private college or university; or
  - 23 d. Pharmaceutical or biotechnology company.
