ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1022

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the commission on
2 legal counsel for indigents; and to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 54-61-01 of the
3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the commission on legal counsel for indigents.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other income, to the
8 commission on legal counsel for indigents for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
9 commission on legal counsel for indigents, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending
10 June 30, 2017, as follows:

1 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 54-61-01 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

3 6. A member of the commission is entitled to reimbursement for travel and expenses as
4 provided by law for other state officers. If not otherwise employed by the state of North
5 Dakota, a member is entitled to receive per diem compensation of sixty-two dollars
6 and fifty cents for each day devoted to attending meetings or performing other duties
7 relating to the official business of the commission. A member of the commission who is
8 a member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive per diem compensation at
9 the rate as provided under section 54-35-10 for each day devoted to attending
10 meetings or performing other duties relating to the official business of the commission.
