AN ACT to amend and reenact section 46-04-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to distribution of session laws and codes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 46-04-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**46-04-05. Distribution of session laws, compilations, and codifications to county officers.**

The board of county commissioners of each county, immediately after the publication of any session laws, codes, or compilations, shall cause a copy thereof to be furnished to the following county officers upon request:

1. Auditor.
2. State's attorney.
3. Ex officio clerk of court.
4. Sheriff.

If any of the offices legally have been combined in the county, only one copy of the session laws, codes, or compilations ~~need requested~~ must be furnished for the combined offices ~~so combined~~. ~~Provided, however, that such~~ Any codifications and copies of the session laws remain the permanent property of the county.
