

# ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

## CHAPTER 72

### HOUSE BILL NO. 1059

(Representatives Owens, Olson, Streyle, B. Koppelman, Beadle, O'Brien, Blum)  
(Senators Holmberg, Meyer)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the employment of individuals under twenty-one years of age at establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6. ~~An~~ A restaurant may employ an individual who is eighteen years of age or older but under twenty-one years of age ~~may be employed by a restaurant as provided in subsection 23 to serve and collect money for alcoholic beverages, if the individual is under the direct supervision of an individual twenty-one or more years of age, but may not be engaged in mixing, dispensing, or consuming alcoholic beverages. Any establishment where~~ that sells alcoholic beverages are sold may employ individuals an individual from eighteen to twenty-one years of age to work ~~in the capacity of musicians on the premises as a musician, disc jockey, or entertainer, or to perform duties directly related to working as a musician, disc jockey, or entertainer if the individual is~~ under the direct supervision of an individual twenty-one or more years of age.
