1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 10 of section 20.1-02-05 of the North
2 Dakota Century Code, relating to allowing physician assistants and advanced practice
3 registered nurses to verify the physical conditions necessary for special hunting permits to be
4 issued to individuals to shoot from stationary motor vehicles.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 10 of section 20.1-02-05 of the North Dakota
7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 10. Issue special permits to shoot wildlife from a stationary motor vehicle upon application
9 from individuals who are physically unable to walk for purposes of hunting or taking
10 wildlife or who have lost the use of an arm at or below the elbow. The application must
11 be accompanied by a ~~physician's statement verifying~~from a physician, physician
12 assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse which verifies the person's individual's
13 condition, and if used to hunt on lands controlled by the board of university and school
14 lands, must designate the land on which the individual intends to hunt. The permittee
15 must have permission from the lessee and the commissioner of university and school
16 lands to hunt on lands controlled by the board of university and school lands. A permit
17 issued under this subsection allows the permittee to drive, or to be driven, onto any
18 land for the purposes of hunting wildlife, except that neither any other passenger
19 within the vehicle nor the driver, if someone other than the permittee, may be a hunter,
20 unless the other ~~person~~individual also is also a permittee. ~~Provided, however, that if~~
21 the land is privately owned and if the permittee is not going to drive or be driven along
22 an established road or trail, the permittee first must ~~first~~ obtain the consent of the
23 owner or lessee to hunt on the land in the manner provided in this title.
