(Higher Education Committee)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management higher education funding formula
- 2 review committee; and to provide for a report.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING FORMULA REVIEW COMMITTEE -

5 REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.

- During the 2019-20 interim, the higher education funding formula review committee is created and composed of eleven members as follows:
 - The Bismarck state college executive vice president, or a designee of the executive vice president;
 - The university of North Dakota vice president for finance and operations, or a designee of the vice president for finance and operations;
 - The North Dakota state university vice president for finance and administration,
 or a designee of the vice president for finance and administration;
 - d. The Minot state university vice president for administration and finance, or a
 designee of the vice president for administration and finance;
 - e. The commissioner of higher education, or a designee of the commissioner;
 - f. Two members of the house of representatives appointed by the majority leader of the house of representatives and one member appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives;
 - g. Two members of the senate appointed by the majority leader of the senate and one member appointed by the minority leader of the senate.
 - 2. The committee shall review the higher education funding formula, including only the appropriateness of certain credit-hour weighting factors and the potential or need for

- additional weighting factors. The legislative council shall provide staff services to the committee.
- 3. The committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislative
