- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-02 and section
- 2 39-07-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to noncriminal traffic violations and halting
- 3 an individual for violating traffic regulations; and to repeal section 39-07-07.1 of the North
- 4 Dakota Century Code, relating to providing envelopes for traffic and parking violations on state
- 5 charitable or penal institution property or state capitol grounds.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-02 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 2. If the individual is cited for a traffic violation under state law and posts bond by mail, the bond must be submitted within fourteen days of the date of the citation and the individual cited shall indicate on the envelope or citation whether a hearing is requested. If the individual does not request a hearing within fourteen days of the date of the citation, the bond is deemed forfeited and the violation admitted. If the individual requests a hearing, the court for the county in which the citation is issued shall issue a summons to the individual requesting the hearing notifying the individual of the date of the hearing before the designated official in accordance with section 39-06.1-03.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-07-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 39-07-07. Halting personan individual for violating traffic regulations Duty of officer halting.
 - Whenever any personan individual is halted for the violation of any of the provisions of chapters 39-01 through 39-13, 39-18, 39-21, and 39-24, or of equivalent city
