1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the commissioner of
2 university and school lands; ~~to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 1 of section~~
3 ~~21-10-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the investments of the state investment~~
4 ~~board; to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 15-01-02 of the North Dakota Century~~
5 ~~Code, relating to the investments of the board of university and school lands; to repeal section~~
6 57-51-15.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the energy impact fund; to provide for
7 transfers; to provide for distributions from permanent funds; to provide an exemption; to provide
8 a report; and to provide an effective date; ~~and to provide a contingent effective date.~~

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

10 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
11 as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from the state lands
12 maintenance fund and the oil and gas impact grant fund in the state treasury to the
13 commissioner of university and school lands for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
14 commissioner of university and school lands, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and
15 ending June 30, 2021, as follows:

SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO THE

SIXTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding items approved by the sixty-fifth legislative assembly for the 2017-19 biennium and the 2019-21 biennium one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

The 2019-21 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2021-23 biennium. The commissioner of university and school lands shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-seventh legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.

SECTION 3. DISTRIBUTIONS TO STATE INSTITUTIONS. Pursuant to article IX of the Constitution of North Dakota, the board of university and school lands shall distribute during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, the following amounts, from the permanent funds managed for the benefit of the following entities:

8 **SECTION 4. TRANSFER - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND TO**
9 **OIL AND GAS IMPACT GRANT FUND.** The office of management and budget shall transfer
10 the sum of \$4,000,000 from the strategic investment and improvements fund to the oil and gas
11 impact grant fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.

12 **SECTION 5. TRANSFER - ENERGY IMPACT FUND TO OIL AND GAS IMPACT GRANT**
13 **FUND.** The commissioner of university and school lands shall transfer any unexpended funds
14 remaining in the energy impact fund when the fund is repealed on June 30, 2021, to the oil and
15 gas impact grant fund.

16 ~~**SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 15-01-02 of the North Dakota Century~~
17 ~~Code is amended and reenacted as follows: _____~~

18 ~~2. Full control of the investment of the permanent funds derived from the sale of any of~~
19 ~~the lands described in subsection 1, which must be made under the supervision of the~~
20 ~~state investment board pursuant to section 21-10-06 subject to the investing authority~~
21 ~~provided in law relating to state investments.~~

22 ~~**SECTION 7.** A new subdivision to subsection 1 of section 21-10-06 of the North Dakota~~
23 ~~Century Code is created and enacted as follows:~~

24 ~~_____ Common schools trust fund and other investments under the control of the board~~
25 ~~of university and school lands.~~

26 **SECTION 6. REPEAL.** Section 57-51-15.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.

27 **SECTION 7. OIL AND GAS IMPACT GRANT FUND.** The grants line item and the total
28 special funds line item in section 1 of this Act include the sum of \$4,000,000 from the oil and
29 gas impact grant fund for grants to political subdivisions impacted by oil and gas development
30 activities.

1 **SECTION 8. EXEMPTION - OIL AND GAS IMPACT GRANT FUND.** The amounts
2 previously appropriated from the oil and gas impact grant fund and identified in section 10 of
3 chapter 38 of the 2017 Session Laws related to the oil and gas impact grant fund, including
4 grant awards returned to the fund, are not subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds
5 are available for grants and administrative costs associated with the fund during the biennium
6 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.

7 **SECTION 9. EXEMPTION - INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROJECT - REPORT TO**
8 **INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE.** The \$3,600,000 appropriated from the state
9 lands maintenance fund and identified in sections 1 and 12 of chapter 38 of the 2017 Session
10 Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds are available to complete
11 the information technology project during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending
12 June 30, 2021. During the 2019-20 interim, the commissioner of university and school lands
13 shall provide at least one report to the interim information technology committee regarding the
14 status of the information technology project.

15 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE** ~~**-CONTINGENT EFFECTIVE DATE.** Sections 6 and 7 of~~
16 ~~this Act become effective on July 1, 2021, or earlier if the commissioner of board and university~~
17 ~~and school lands notifies the legislative council that the board of university and school lands~~
18 ~~approved, by a majority vote, transferring the board of university and school lands' investments~~
19 ~~to the state investment board.~~ Section 86 of this Act becomes effective on June 30, 2021.
