- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 36-01-36 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to animal identification program records; and to amend and reenact section 36-01-32 of
- 3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the development and maintenance of animal
- 4 tracking databases.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 36-01-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 36-01-32. Duties Animal tracking.
- 9 The board shall develop and maintain an animal tracking databased to assist with 10 tracking animal movements for animal health purposes only. The information obtained and
- 11 maintained in the <u>databasedatabases</u> is subject to open records laws as provided for in section
- 12 36-09-2836-01-36.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** Section 36-01-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as
- 14 follows:
- 15 <u>36-01-36. Premises identification, animal identification, and animal tracking Open</u>
- 16 records Exception.
- 17 <u>1. The board shall maintain the confidentiality of information created, collected, or</u>
- maintained by the state veterinarian for purposes of premises identification, animal
- 19 <u>identification, or animal tracking, including the name and address of the owner or</u>
- 20 <u>lessee of the property where an animal found, is located.</u>
- 21 2. The information described in subsection 1 is not subject to section 44-04-18 and may
- 22 not be disclosed unless:
- 23 <u>a. Every individual who is the subject of the information provides written consent to</u>
- 24 the release of information;

1 The disclosure is authorized pursuant to federal law; 2 The disclosure is necessary to provide a state or federal agency with information <u>C.</u> 3 to assist in animal disease control or tracing an animal disease; 4 The disclosure is to the attorney general or to law enforcement to assist in a <u>d.</u> 5 criminal investigation; 6 A court of competent jurisdiction orders the disclosure; or <u>e.</u> 7 f. The disclosure is to provide the North Dakota stockmen's association with 8 information pursuant to section 4.1-72-05. 9 A person violating this section is subject to the remedies set forth in section <u>3.</u> 10 44-04-21.2. For purposes of applying section 44-04-21.2, "public entity" includes any 11 person that has contracted with the state for the provision of services related to a 12 premises identification, animal identification, or animal tracking database program.
