Sixty-sixth Legislative Assembly

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Bismarck, February 27, 2019

FIRST READING OF SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

SCR 4001: A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 9 of article III of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to the process for approving constitutional amendments.

SCR 4002: A concurrent resolution urging Congress to address the rising costs and availability of medications and health care for individuals with diabetes and coverage of those costs.
