1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of

2 corrections and rehabilitation; to provide for a report; and to provide an exemption.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the department of corrections and rehabilitation for the purpose of defraying
the expenses of the department of corrections and rehabilitation, for the biennium beginning
July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

20 appropriations committees of the sixty-eighth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time

funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

22 SECTION 3. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION OPERATING

23 **FUND REVENUES.** Any moneys received by the department of corrections and rehabilitation

24 from correctional supervision, electronic monitoring, and detention; reimbursements from other

25 agencies; profits received from department of corrections and rehabilitation commissary;

26 miscellaneous revenue, including offender fines, fees, restitution, and medical copayments; and

27 from the youth correctional center permanent fund, may be deposited in the department of

28 corrections and rehabilitation operating fund and expended pursuant to legislative appropriation

for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

30 SECTION 4. EXEMPTION - COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM. The

31 amount of \$7,000,000 from the general fund appropriated for the community behavioral health

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- 1 program in section 1 of chapter 15 of the 2019 Session Laws is not subject to section
- 2 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used for the community
- 3 behavioral health program during the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30,
- 4 2023.

5 SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - DEFERRED MAINTENANCE AND EXTRAORDINARY

- 6 **REPAIRS.** Notwithstanding any amount continued under section 4 of this Act, up to \$6,000,000
- 7 from the general fund appropriated to the department of corrections and rehabilitation in
- 8 section 1 of chapter 15 of the 2019 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11, and any
- 9 unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used for deferred maintenance and
- 10 extraordinary repairs projects by the department of corrections and rehabilitation during the
- 11 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.
