1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-16-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the number of board members for water resource districts encompassing one county.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 61-16-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 61-16-07. Water resource board - Appointment and number.

7 When a water resource district has been created, and the state water commission has filed 8 notice with the county auditor of a county where the district or a part thereof of the district is 9 situated, a water resource board shallmust be appointed within ninety days, as provided herein. 10 If the district's boundaries are confined to one county, the board of county commissioners shall 11 appoint a water resource board consisting of three or five an odd number of managers not to 12 exceed seven. A water resource board for a district including two or more counties must have 13 seven managers appointed by the boards of county commissioners of the respective counties in 14 the district pursuant to this section. When a district includes two counties, the water resource 15 board shallmust consist of five managers, three appointed by the board of county-16 commissioners offour managers from the county havingwith the larger aggregate taxable 17 valuation of property, and two appointed by the board of county commissioners of three 18 managers from the other county. If a district includes three counties, the water resource board 19 shallmust consist of five managers, one appointed by the board of county commissioners 20 havingthree managers from the county with the lowest largest aggregate taxable valuation of 21 property in the district, and two appointed by the board of county commissioners of managers. 22 from each of the other two counties. If a district includes four or six counties, the water resource 23 board shallmust consist of two members three managers from the county having with the largest 24 aggregate taxable valuation of property in the district, two managers from the county with the

- 2 each of the other counties. If a district includes five or seven counties, the water resource board
- 3 shall<u>must</u> consist of two managers from each of the two counties with the two largest aggregate
- 4 <u>taxable valuations of property in the district, and one manager from each countyof the other</u>
- 5 <u>counties</u>. Appointments to the water resource board shall<u>must</u> be made by the boards of county-
- 6 commissioners of the respective counties of a district includes six counties, the water resource
- 7 board must consist of two managers from the county with the largest aggregate taxable
- 8 valuation of property in the district, and one member from each of the other counties. If a district
- 9 includes seven counties, the water resource board must consist of one manager from each
- 10 <u>county</u>.
