HB 1147 Expands infertility coverage in the NDPERS Health Plan and provides for a \$50,000 benefit maximum.

The bill would increase plan payments for infertility services. The bill would increase the plan's current \$20,000 individual lifetime maximum for infertility services to \$50,000. Modeling estimates an overall impact of 0.3% in claim payments.
