- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12-44.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the confidentiality of booking photos; and to amend and reenact
- 3 subsection 2 of section 44-04-18.7 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal
- 4 information.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 **Prohibition Booking photo Confidential.**
- Unless there is a compelling public safety or law enforcement interest warranting
 release, the booking photo of an arrestee is a confidential record until the arrestee:
- 11 <u>a. Fails to appear for court;</u>
- 12 <u>b.</u> <u>Is a fugitive from justice; or</u>
- 13 <u>c. Is convicted of the offense for which the arrestee was arrested or an offense</u>
 related to the offense for which the arrestee was arrested.
- This section does not prohibit the dissemination of booking photos among or on behalf
 of law enforcement agencies or officers.
- 17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 44-04-18.7 of the North Dakota
- 18 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 2. "Criminal intelligence and investigative information" does not include:
- a. Arrestee description, including name, date of birth, address, race, sex, physical
 description, and occupation of arrestee.
- b. Facts concerning the arrest, including the cause of arrest and the name of thearresting officer.
