- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a student teacher scholarship program; and to provide an
- 3 appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Student teacher scholarship program - Administered by the board.</u>

- 9a."Remote school district" has the same meaning as the term is defined in the 200610national center for education statistics locale codes.
- 11 b. "Rural school district" has the same meaning as the term is defined in the 2006
 12 national center for education statistics locale codes.
- 13 <u>c.</u> "Student teacher" means an individual enrolled in a state-approved educator
 14 preparation program in this state who is completing the qualifications to become
- a licensed teacher, and who has signed a contract to teach at a rural school
 district under the supervision of a licensed teacher.
- 17 <u>2.</u> <u>The state board of higher education shall administer a student teacher scholarship</u>
- 18 program. The board shall adopt rules to administer the program including rules
- 19 <u>establishing an application process and distribution of program scholarships. An</u>
- 20 <u>eligible student teacher may apply to the board to receive a scholarship under the</u>
 21 <u>program.</u>
- 22 <u>3.</u> <u>To be eligible to receive a scholarship under this section, an individual:</u>
- 23 <u>a.</u> <u>Must be enrolled in a state-approved educator preparation program in this state;</u>

11		<u>b.</u>	<u>Mus</u>	t demonstrate a teacher shortage, as determined by the board;	
12		<u>C.</u>	<u>Mus</u>	t be willing to supervise, mentor, and train a student teacher; and	
13		<u>d.</u>	<u>Mus</u>	t be able to provide the student teacher lodging accommodations within a	
14			reas	onable distance from the school of placement and at a reasonable rental	
15			rate	as determined by the board.	
16	<u>5.</u>	<u>Sub</u>	pject to legislative appropriation:		
17		<u>a.</u>	<u>The</u>	board may award and distribute up to thirty-three scholarships during each	
18			year	of the biennium; and	
19		<u>b.</u>	<u>The</u>	board shall distribute up to fifteen thousand dollars to an eligible individual	
20			<u>awa</u>	rded a scholarship under the program. A scholarship may be used to pay:	
21			<u>(1)</u>	The cost of tuition; and	
22			<u>(2)</u>	Living expenses while student teaching, including rent, food, clothing, and	
23				travel to the school and district of placement.	
24	<u>6.</u>	<u>The</u>	e board may contract with a third-party organization to administer the program and		
25	supervise the student teachers participating in the program.				
26	SEC		N 2. A	PPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general	
27	fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the				
28	sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing				
29	scholarships to eligible student teachers under the student teacher scholarship program, for the				
30	biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. A school district shall provide one				

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- 1 dollar of matching funds for each one dollar from the general fund for student teachers hired
- 2 under this Act.
