- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 19-02.1-16.5 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to limitations on pharmacy benefits managers; to amend and reenact section
- 3 43-15-25.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to permitting pharmacists to administer
- 4 SARS-CoV-2 tests; to provide a penalty; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 19-02.1-16.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 7 enacted as follows:
- 8 Pharmacy benefits managers Prohibition on discrimination Penalty.
- 9 1. As used in this section:
- a. "Pharmacy" means a pharmacy licensed under the laws of this state.
- b. "Pharmacy benefits manager" has the same meaning as in section 19-03.6-01.
- 12 <u>2. A pharmacy benefits manager may not discriminate against or interfere with a covered</u>
- entity participating under section 340B of the federal Public Health Service Act
- 14 [42 U.S.C. 201 et seq.] or a pharmacy under contract with a covered entity under
- 15 <u>section 340B of the federal Public Health Service Act to provide pharmacy services on</u>
- 16 behalf of the covered entity. This includes refusing to contract with a pharmacy.
- 17 3. A pharmacy benefits manager may not modify, by contract, provider manual, or other
- means, the definition of pharmacy as defined in this section, reimburse a lower dollar
- amount for a drug purchased under 340B than if the drug had been purchased outside
- 20 <u>340B, or interfere with any section 340B pharmacy service between the covered entity</u>
- 21 <u>and the contracted pharmacy.</u>
- 4. A pharmacy benefits manager may not directly or indirectly, on behalf of a pharmacy
- benefits manager, a carrier, or a health plan, charge or hold a pharmacy responsible

1 for a fee for any step, component, or mechanism related to the claims adjudication 2 processing network. 3 <u>5.</u> Contract and claim information between the covered entity and contracted pharmacy 4 is confidential. 5 A pharmacy benefits manager that violates this section is guilty of a class B 6 misdemeanor for each violation occurrence. 7 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-15-25.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows: 9 43-15-25.3. Approved laboratory tests. 10 Approved laboratory tests are the following waived screening tests: glucose monitoring 11 devices (FDA cleared/home use) 9221, cholesterol 1020, HDL cholesterol 2550, triglyceride 12 6118, and glycosylated hemoglobin (Hgb A1C) 2204, and SARS-CoV-2. Additional tests may be 13 added to this list as jointly determined by the board and the North Dakota board of medicine. 14 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
