2	Constitution of North Dakota, relating to the state hospital and terminology.			
3	STATEMENT OF INTENT			
4	This me	easure would update terminology, remove the requirement that the state hospital be		
5	located in Jamestown, and remove authorization for an additional state hospital.			
6	BE IT R	RESOLVED BY THE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE		
7	CONCURRING THEREIN:			
8	That the following proposed amendments to sections 12 and 13 of article IX of the			
9	Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of			
10	North Dakota at the general election to be held in 2024, in accordance with section 16 of			
11	article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.			
12	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12 of article IX of the Constitution of North Dakota is			
13	amended and reenacted as follows:			
14	Section 12. The following public institutions of the state are permanently located at the			
15	places hereinafter named, each to have the lands specifically granted to it by the United States			
16	in the Act of Congress approved February 22, 1889, to be disposed of and used in such manner			
17	as the legislative assembly may prescribe subject to the limitations provided in the article on			
18	school and public lands contained in this constitution.			
19	1.	The seat of government at the city of Bismarck in the county of Burleigh.		
20	2.	The state university and the school of mines at the city of Grand Forks, in the county		
21		of Grand Forks.		
22	3.	The North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science at the city of		
23		Fargo, in the county of Cass.		
24	4.	A state normal school at the city of Valley City, in the county of Barnes, and the		
25		legislative assembly, in apportioning the grant of eighty thousand acres of land for

1		normal schools made in the Act of Congress referred to shall grant to the said normal	
2		school at Valley City, as aforementioned, fifty thousand (50,000) acres, and said lands	
3		are hereby appropriated to said institution for that purpose.	
4	5.	The school for the deaf and dumb of North Dakotahearing impaired at the city of	
5		Devils Lake, in the county of Ramsey.	
6	6.	A state training school at the city of Mandan, in the county of Morton.	
7	7.	A state normal school at the city of Mayville, in the county of Traill, and the legislative	
8		assembly in apportioning the grant of lands made by Congress in the Act aforesaid for	
9		state normal schools shall assign thirty thousand (30,000) acres to the institution	
10		hereby located at Mayville, and said lands are hereby appropriated for said purpose.	
11	8.	A state hospital for the insane at the city of Jamestown, in the county of Stutsmancare	
12		of individuals with mental illness. And the legislative assembly shall appropriate twenty	
13		thousand acres of the grant of lands made by the Act of Congress aforesaid for other	
14		educational and charitable institutions to the benefit and for the endowment of said	
15		institution, and there shall be located at or near the city of Grafton, in the county of	
16		Walsh, an institutiona facility for the feebleminded individuals with developmental	
17		$\underline{\text{disabilities}},$ on the grounds purchased by the secretary of the interior for a penitentiary	
18		building.	
19	SEC	TION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 13 of article IX of the Constitution of North Dakota is	
20	amended and reenacted as follows:		
21	Sect	tion 13. The following public institutions are located as provided, each to have so much	
22	of the remaining grant of one hundred seventy thousand acres of land made by the United		
23	States for "other educational and charitable institutions" as is allotted by law:		
24	1.	A soldiers' home, when located, or such other charitable institution as the legislative	
25		assembly may determine, at the city of Lisbon in the county of Ransom, with a grant of	
26		forty thousand acres of land.	
27	2.	The school for the blind at the city of Grand Forks in the county of Grand Forks or at	
28		such other location as may be determined by the legislative assembly to be in the best	
29		interests of the students of such institution and the state of North Dakota.	
30	3.	A school of forestry, or such other institution as the legislative assembly may	
31		determine, at such place in one of the counties of McHenry, Ward, Bottineau, or

1		Rolette, as the electors of said counties may determine by an election for that
2		purpose, to be held as provided by the legislative assembly.
3	4.	A school of science or such other educational or charitable institution as the legislative
4		assembly may prescribe, at the city of Wahpeton in the county of Richland, with a
5		grant of forty thousand acres.
6	5.	A state college at the city of Minot in the county of Ward.
7	6.	A state college at the city of Dickinson in the county of Stark.
8	<del>7.</del>	A state hospital for the mentally ill at such place within this state as shall be selected
9		by the legislative assembly.
10	No other institution of a character similar to any one of those located by article IX section 12 or

- 11 this section shall be established or maintained without an amendment of this constitution.
