8	Tha	That the following proposed amendment to section 13 of article IX of the Constitution of		
9	North D	orth Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the		
10	general election to be held in 2024, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the			
11	Constitution of North Dakota.			
12	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 13 of article IX of the Constitution of North Dakota is			
13	amended and reenacted as follows:			
14	Section 13. The following public institutions are located as provided, each to have so much			
15	of the remaining grant of one hundred seventy thousand acres of land made by the United			
16	States for "other educational and charitable institutions" as is allotted by law:			
17	1.	A soldiers' home, when located, or such other	er charitable institution as the legislative	
18		assembly may determine, at the city of Lisbo	on in the county of Ransom, with a grant of	
19		forty thousand acres of land.		
20	2.	The school for the blind at the city of Grand	Forks in the county of Grand Forks or at	
21	such other location as may be determined by the legislative assembly to be in the bes			
22		interests of the students of such institution a	nd the state of North Dakota.

- 7. A state hospital for the mentally ill at such place within this state as shall be selected
