- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 1-08 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to exemption of recognition of daylight saving time; and to repeal section
- 3 40-01-20 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to daylight saving time.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 Standard time.

## 8 <u>1.</u> Under 15 U.S.C. 260(a), the state is exempt from the establishment of daylight saving 9 time.

- <u>Creenwich mean time minus five hours is the official standard time of the portions of</u>
   <u>the state in the central time zone.</u>
- 3. Greenwich mean time minus six hours is the official standard time of the portions of
   the state in the mountain time zone.
- 14 <u>4.</u> <u>This section may not affect the standard time established by United States law</u>
- 15 governing the movements of common carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the
- 16 time for performance of an act by an officer or department of the United States, as
- 17 <u>established by a statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United States or an</u>
- 18 <u>agency of the United States.</u>
- 19 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Section 40-01-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
