A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the governor; to amend and reenact sections 54-07-04 and 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salaries of the governor and lieutenant governor; to repeal section 3 of chapter 26 of the 2019 Session Laws, relating to the appropriation of additional income to the office of the governor; to provide an exemption; to provide for a report; and to declare an

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

11	amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated to the governor's office, any				
12	additional income from federal or other funds, excluding federal funds, which may become				
13	available to the governor's office, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021 period beginning with				
14	the effective date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2023. Any other funds received under this				
15	section must be used for the specific purpose intended for the funds or transferred to the				
16	appropriate state agency or institution. Upon the receipt of other funds under this section, the				
17	governor's office shall provide a report to the budget section regarding the source, amount, and				
18	purpose of the funds received. The gove	ernor's office may not	expend other funds	under this

1	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 54-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
2	amended and reenacted as follows:
3	54-07-04. Salary of governor.
4	The annual salary of the governor is one hundred thirty-fiveforty thousand three eight
5	hundred sixty-fourtwenty-nine dollars through June 30, 20202022, and one hundred thirty-
6	eightforty-twoforty-three thousand sevenninesix hundred forty-eightforty-oneforty-six dollars
7	thereafter.
8	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
9	amended and reenacted as follows:
10	54-08-03. Salary of lieutenant governor.
11	The annual salary of the lieutenant governor is one hundred fivenine thousand twofive
12	hundred eighty-fivethirty-six dollars through June 30, 20202022, and one hundred seven eleven
13	thousand nineoneseven hundred seventeenseventy-ninetwenty-seven dollars thereafter.
14	SECTION 7. REPEAL. Section 3 of chapter 26 of the 2019 session laws is repealed.
15	SECTION 8. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - 2019-21 BIENNIUM.
16	Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the office of management and budget may transfer up to
17	\$64,242 of appropriation authority from the operating expenses line item to the salaries and
18	wages line item in section 1 of chapter 26 of the 2019 session laws as requested by the
19	governor.
20	SECTION 9. EXEMPTION. The funding appropriated in the rough rider awards line item in
21	section 1 of chapter 26 of the 2019 session laws is not subject to the provisions of section
22	54-44.1-11 and may be continued into the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending
23	June 30, 2023.
24	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY. Section 6 Sections 3, 7, and 8 of this Act is are declared to be
25	an emergency measure.
