- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-13-23 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to school guidance and counseling services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-13-23 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 15.1-13-23. School guidance and counseling services - Providers.

- Notwithstanding any other law, <u>if an individual possesses a bachelor's degree from an</u>
 accredited institution in the field of counseling and is enrolled in courses to obtain a
 graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling program, the
 board shall issue a provisional two-year license to the individual to provide guidance
 and counseling services at the elementary and secondary school level. The licensee
- 12 <u>must obtain a graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling</u>
- program within two years of the date the provisional license was issued to be eligible
 for license renewal.
- <u>Guidance and counseling services at the elementary and secondary school level may</u>
 be provided by a person holding a graduate degree in counseling from a
- 17 state-approved school counseling program, with coursework and an internship in
- 18 school counseling, as required for all counselors by the superintendent of public
- instruction, provided the person has a North Dakota teaching license or will obtain onewithin seven years from the date of first employment under this section.
- 3. The board shall conduct a criminal history record check in accordance with section
 12-60-24 on each person hired under this section. All costs associated with a
 background check are the responsibility of the person being hired.

1	<u>4.</u>	The board shall monitor a person hired under subsection 1 to ensure the individual
2		completes at least one-half of the total credits required for the individual to obtain a
3		graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling program
4		within the first calendar year after the date the provisional license is issued.
5	<u>5.</u>	The board shall monitor a person hired under this section subsection 2 to ensure that
6		the person annually completes at least one-seventh of the total credits required for
7		thatthe person to obtain a teaching license, as determined at the time of employment
8		under this section.
