- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 29-29 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to prohibiting entry onto private land without permission.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 29-29 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Law enforcement entry onto private land without permission prohibited Exception.</u>
- 7 <u>1. As used in this section, "law enforcement officer" has the meaning provided in section</u> 8 12.1-01-04.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law and subject to subsection 3, a law
  enforcement officer may not enter private land unless the law enforcement officer
  receives permission from the landowner or a lessee of the land.
- 12 <u>3. A law enforcement officer may enter private land without permission if:</u>
- 13 <u>a. Probable cause exists that a violation of law has occurred, is occurring, or is about to occur;</u>
- b. A search warrant has been issued; or
- 16 <u>c.</u> Responding to an emergency situation, accident, or other threat to public safety.
