## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 29-29 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows: 6 Law enforcement entry onto private land property for search and seizure without 7 permission prohibited - Exception. 8 As used in this section, "law enforcement officer" has the meaning provided in section 1. 9 12.1-01-04. 10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law and subject to subsection 3, a law 2. 11 enforcement officer may not enter private landproperty for search and seizure unless 12 the law enforcement officer receives permission from the landowner owner or a lessee 13 of the landproperty. 14 3. A law enforcement officer may enter private landproperty without permission if: 15 Probable cause exists that a violation of law has occurred, is occurring, or is a. 16 about to occur: 17 A search warrant has been issued; or b. 18 Responding to an emergency situation, accident, or other threat to public safety; <u>C.</u> 19 or 20 Fulfilling a lawful exercise of duties. d.
