- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a tuition scholarship program for students taking dual-credit courses
- 3 while in high school; and to provide an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

8	<u>1.</u>	The	e state board of higher education shall administer a dual-credit tuition scholarship
9		prog	gram to offer a tuition scholarship to students. The board shall adopt procedures to

11	<u>2.</u>	<u>An</u>	eligible student may apply to the board to receive a scholarship toward the cost of
12		<u>tuiti</u>	on and fees at the state-approved postsecondary training program, tribal college,
13		<u>or p</u>	vivate institution of higher education at which the student is enrolled. To be eligible
14		<u>to re</u>	eceive a scholarship, an individual must:
15		<u>a.</u>	Be enrolled at a state-approved postsecondary training program in the state,
16			tribal college in the state, or private institution of higher education in the state;
17		<u>b.</u>	Have completed at least one semester, quarter, or term at the state-approved
18			postsecondary training program, tribal college, or private institution at which the
19			student is enrolled:
20		<u>C.</u>	Have graduated from a high school in the state or from a high school in a school
21			district that borders the state, or have completed a program of home education
22			under chapter 15.1-23; and
23		<u>d.</u>	Have completed at least one dual-credit course provided by an institution under
24			the control of the state board of higher education while enrolled in high school or

1		a program of home education in the state, or a high school in a school district that		
2		borders the state.		
3	<u>3.</u>	The state board of higher education shall provide an eligible student with a tuition		
4		scholarship equal to the cost of the dual-credit courses provided by an institution		
5		under the control of the state board of higher education completed by the student		
6		while in high school or a program of home education, in an amount up to one		
7		thousand five hundred dollars. A scholarship received by a student during any		
8		semester, quarter, or term of enrollment under this section may not exceed the cost of		
9		tuition and fees for the semester, quarter, or term.		
10	SEC	TION 2. APPROPRIATION - BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA PROFITS. There is		
11	appropri	ated out of any moneys from the Bank of North Dakota's current earnings and		
12	undivided profits, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,000,000, or so much of the sum as			
13	may be	necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing tuition		
14	scholars	hips to eligible students participating in the program under this Act, for the biennium		
15	beginnir	ng July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.
