- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-21-02.6 and 15.1-21-02.7 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to resident student eligibility to receive both the North Dakota
- 3 academic and career and technical education scholarships.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-02.6 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 15.1-21-02.6. North Dakota scholarship - Amount - Applicability.

16			<u>(2)</u>	Seven hundred fifty dollars for the North Dakota career and technical	
17				education scholarship for each semester during which the student is	
18				enrolled full time at an accredited institution of higher education in this state,	
19				maintains a cumulative grade point average of 2.75, and maintains progress	
20				toward degree completion; or	
21			<u>(3)</u>	One thousand five hundred dollars for the North Dakota academic	
22				scholarship and the North Dakota career and technical education	
23				scholarship, if the student satisfies the requirements of both sections

27	3.	A stude	ent is not entitled to receive more than six thousand dollars for a North Dakota				
28		<u>acader</u>	nic or career and technical education scholarship under this section, unless the				
29		<u>studen</u>	t is eligible to receive both scholarships. A student eligible to receive both a				
30		<u>North [</u>	Dakota academic and career and technical education scholarship is not entitled				
31		<u>to rece</u>	ive more than twelve thousand dollars under this section.

3	5.	a.	(1) This section does not require a student to be enrolled in consecutive		
4			semesters.		
5			(2) This section does not require a student to be enrolled in consecutive		
6			quarters.		
7		b.	A scholarship under this section is valid only for six academic years after the		
8			student's graduation from high school and may be applied to a graduate program.		
9	6.	A scholarship under this section is available to any eligible resident student			
10		the	requirements of section 15.1-21-02.4 or 15.1-21-02.5 and who:		
11		a.	Graduates from a high school in this state;		
12		b.	Graduates from a high school in a bordering state under chapter 15.1-29;		
13		C.	Graduates from a nonpublic high school in a bordering state while residing with a		
14			custodial parent in this state; or		
15		d.	Completes a program of home education supervised in accordance with chapter		
16			15.1-23.		
17	7.	a.	For purposes of North Dakota scholarship eligibility under this section, "full-time"		
18			has the same meaning as the term is defined by the institution the student is		
19			attending.		
20		b.	A student who is enrolled less than full-time may retain scholarship eligibility if the		
21			student is in the final semester or quarter before graduation. The waiver of the		
22			full-time enrollment status requirement for scholarship eligibility may not apply to		
23			a student more than once.		
24		C.	For the purpose of North Dakota scholarship eligibility under this section,		
25			"progress toward degree completion" means earning the following minimum		
26			number of credits after each semester or quarter term disbursement to qualify for		
27			the subsequent disbursement:		
28			(1) Twenty-four credits after disbursement two;		
29			(2) Thirty-nine credits after disbursement three;		
30			(3) Fifty-four credits after disbursement four;		
31			(4) Sixty-nine credits after disbursement five;		

1		(5) Eighty-four credits after disbursement six; and							
2		(6) Ninety-nine credits after disbursement seven.							
3	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-02.7 of the North Dakota Century Code is								
4	4 amended and reenacted as follows:								
5	5 15.1-21-02.7. North Dakota scholarship opportunities - 2009-10 high school								
6	6 graduates.								
7	1.	Except as provided in subsection 3, any resident student who graduates from a high							
8		school during the 2009-10 school year is eligible to receive a North Dakota academic							
9		scholarship, provided the student is certified by the superintendent of public instruction							
10		as having obtained a composite score of at least twenty-four on an ACT.							
11	2.	Except as provided in subsection 3, any resident student who graduates from a high							
12		school during the 2009-10 school year is eligible to receive a North Dakota technical							
13		scholarship, provided the student is certified by the superintendent of public instruction							
14		as having obtained:							
15		a. A composite score of at least twenty-four on an ACT; or							
16		b. A score of at least five on each of three WorkKeys assessments recommended							
17		by the department of career and technical education and approved by the							
18		superintendent of public instruction.							
19	3.	A student is eligible to receive a scholarship under either subsection 1 or 2, but may-							
20		not receive a scholarship under both subsections.
