PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1045

That the Senate recede from its amendments as printed on page 1073 of the House Journal and pages 743 and 744 of the Senate Journal and that Engrossed House Bill No. 1045 be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 1, replace "two" with "three"

Page 1, line 2, after "to" insert "prohibited acts and"

Page 1, line 9, overstrike "**Hemp (cannabis sativa L.)**" and insert immediately thereafter "**Definitions**"

Page 1, after line 9, insert:

"1."

Page 1, line 12, after "delta-9" insert "total"

- Page 1, line 13, after the period insert "The term does not include any commodity or product using hemp which exceeds the allowable amount of total tetrahydrocannabinol determined by the commissioner.
 - <u>"Tetrahydrocannabinol" means delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol and any structural, optical, or geometric isomers of tetrahydrocannabinol, including:</u>
 - <u>a.</u> <u>Delta-7 tetrahydrocannabinol;</u>
 - b. Delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol; and
 - c. <u>Delta-10 tetrahydrocannabinol.</u>
 - 3. "Total tetrahydrocannabinol" means the sum of the percentage, by weight, of tetrahydrocannabinolic acid multiplied by eight hundred seventy-seven thousandths plus the percentage of weight of tetrahydrocannabinol."

Page 1, line 17, after "the" insert "total"

Page 1, line 18, replace "in compliance with" with "not to exceed"

Page 2, after line 6, insert:

"**SECTION 4.** A new section to chapter 4.1-18.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Prohibited acts.

A licensee may not:

 Engage in the isomerization of cannabinoids to create isomers of tetrahydrocannabinol, including delta-8, delta-9, and delta-10 tetrahydrocannabinol; and 2. Sell hemp or hemp products that were created using the isomerization of cannabinoids to create isomers of tetrahydrocannabinol, including delta-8, delta-9, and delta-10 tetrahydrocannabinol."
