- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact subsection 5 of section 16.1-03-07 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to district party organization; to amend and reenact section 16.1-03-17
- 3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to political party reorganization after redistricting;
- 4 and to provide an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** Subsection 5 of section 16.1-03-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 5. After redistricting of the legislative assembly becomes effective, the state party chair may appoint a temporary district party organization chair in any newly established district or a district that lacks a district committee able to carry out the responsibilities of this chapter. The temporary district party organization chair shall organize the district political party as closely as possible in conformance with this chapter to assure compliance with primary election filing deadlines.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 16.1-03-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 16.1-03-17. Political party reorganization after redistricting.
- If redistricting of the legislative assembly becomes effective after the organization of political parties as provided in this chapter and before the primary or the general election, the political parties, in the newly established precincts and each of the following districts, shall proceed-toorganize or reorganize as closely as possible in conformance with this chapter to assure compliance with primary election filing deadlines:
- A district that does not share any geographical area with the pre-redistricting district
 having the same number.
