Chairman Johnson, Vice-Chair Trottier, and Members of the Committee, I am writing in support of HB 1437 on behalf of the Richland County Water Resource District. HB 1437 is the result of Ellingson Companies, Representative Schreiber-Beck, and Water Resource District Representatives working together to make Subsurface Water Management permitting less cumbersome and to provide for a more timely approval process.
