Example: COVID analysis

- Helped identify how the pandemic is changing the incarceration and supervision communities during the pandemic
- Helped monitor reincarceration of release cohorts



Summary snapshot of vitals during COVID

	Population	Admissions / Starts	Length of Stay
Prison	-25%	-45%	+9%
Parole	+9%	-16%	No Change
Probation	-6%	-40%	+6%

- Prison population declined significantly as transfers from county jails slowed, offering a potential new baseline
- Probation population saw a decrease from fewer admissions from court, while parole population grew due to prison releases in Q1 and Q2
- Fewer revocations during COVID may be contributing to rise in parole population


