

To the North Dakota State Legislature:

I believe the North Dakota governor should not have the unilateral authority to order citizens under penalty of fine or prosecution to wear anything such as a mask, or 2 masks, or 3 masks, or whatever (including seat belts and motorcycle helmets), or to take away the constitutional right to assemble, such as attending church, eating at any food establishment, going to any business, etc. and should only be a recommendation, and that only for a limited time, 30 days. An extension of such an order should only be allowed by ND legislature, thus giving the citizens involved an opportunity to approve or disapprove any such action, remember, if it only affects my safety then it should be my decision and mine alone.
