I respectfully ask that you support HB1104. My great nephew, Zach Schmidkunz, was very young when incarcerated in the North Dakota State Penitentiary. If required to serve 85% of his sentence he will serve another 8 years. If HB1104 is implemented he would need to serve another 2 years. Zach and many others who were so young when convicted could have additional years to be active, contributing members of society should HB1104 be passed. Zach has been a model prisoner as have many others currently serving long sentences for crimes committed many years ago. They are not the same people they were then.
