- Except as provided in subsection 2, the governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall
 prohibit a nonresident from hunting for the first seven days of the pheasant season on
 land owned or private land enrolled by the department for the purposes of hunting or
 on land for which the department pays in lieu of tax payments.
- 12 <u>A nonresident with a valid small game hunting license may hunt pheasant during the</u>
 13 <u>first seven days of the pheasant season if:</u>
- 14 a. The nonresident is an individual participating landowner whose owns property is
