- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-06 and subsection 3 of section
- 2 39-06.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the amount of statutory fees and
- 3 points for speeding violations; and to provide a penalty for an Act to amend and reenact section
- 4 39-06.1-06, subsection 3 of section 39-06.1-10, and sections 40-05-06 and 40-11-12 of the
- 5 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the amount of statutory fees, points for speeding
- 6 violations, city fines, and the nonpayment of fines; and to provide a penalty.

#### 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 amended and reenacted as follows: 10 39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees. 11 The fees required for a noncriminal disposition under section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 must 12 be as follows: 13 1. For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of twenty dollars 14 except for a violation of any traffic parking regulation on any state charitable or penal-15 institution property or on the state capitol grounds, a fee in the amount of five dollars, 16 excluding a violation of subsection 11 of section 39-01-15. 17 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except 18 for: 19 A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, or 39-10-42, a fee of fifty 20 dollars. 21 A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or 22 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars. 23 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.

25	8.6. For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of
26	section 39-09-02, a fee of forty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the
27	posted speed; and forty dollars, plus one dollar for each additional mile per hour over-
28	ten miles per hour over the limit unless a greater fee would be applicable under this
29	sectionplus five dollars for each mile per hour over the limit.
30	9.7. For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of
31	section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the

1 posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles 2 per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this sectionplus 3 five dollars for each mile per hour over the limit. The fee in this subsection does not 4 apply to a highway construction zone unless individuals engaged in construction are 5 present at the time and place of the violation and the posted speed limit sign states 6 "Minimum Fee \$80". 7 SECTION 2. For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of section 39-09-02, a fee of forty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the posted speed; and forty dollars, plus one dollar for each additional mile per hour over ten miles per hour over the limit unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section.
- 9.7. For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section.

  The fee in this subsection does not apply to a highway construction zone unless individuals engaged in construction are present at the time and place of the violation and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum Fee \$80".

For every violation of a city ordinance enforcing the requirements of title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, section 403 relating to publicly owned treatment works, or prohibiting shoplifting, vandalism, criminal mischief, or malicious mischief, the penalty may not exceed a fine of one thousand five hundred dollars, imprisonment for thirty days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
- 4.3. This section does not prohibit the use of the sentencing alternatives, other than a fine or imprisonment, provided by section 12.1-32-02 for the violation of a city ordinance, nor does this section limit the use of deferred or suspended sentences under subsections 3 and 4 of section 12.1-32-02.

**SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 40-11-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

#### 40-11-12. Commitment of guilty person for nonpayment of fines or costs.

Any person upon whom any fine or costs, or both, has been imposed for violation of a municipal ordinance may, after hearing, be committed upon order of the court to jail or other place provided by the municipality for the incarceration of offenders until the fine or costs, or both, are fully paid or discharged by labor as provided in section 40-18-12. The court may not commit a person under this section when the sole reason for the person's nonpayment of fines or costs, or both, is the person's indigency. An order of commitment under this section shall not be for a period in excess of thirty days. As used in this section, "fine" does not include a fee established pursuant to subsection 2 of section 40-05-06.
