STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT

This amendment adds a one-time grant of \$5.9 million from special funds made available from 2019-21 biennium carryover for the development of science experiments and science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics (STEAM) education, including space that is accessible in compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act and equipment needed for all children, at a hybrid children's museum-science center in Minot.
