1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North D
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- 2 Century Code, relating to a student teacher scholarship program; and to provide an
- 3 appropriation.

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#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows:

# Student teacher scholarship program - Administered by the board.

- 1. For purposes of this section:
  - "Remote school district" has the same meaning as the term is defined in the 2006 a. national center for education statistics locale codes.
- <u>b.</u> "Rural school district" has the same meaning as the term is defined in the 2006 12 national center for education statistics locale codes.
- 13 "Student teacher" means an individual enrolled in a state-approved educator <u>C.</u> 14 preparation program in this state who is completing the qualifications to become 15 a licensed teacher, and who has signed a contract received full placement to student teach at a rural school
- 16 district under the supervision of a licensed teacher.
- 17 2. The state board of higher education shall administer a student teacher scholarship program. The board shall adopt rules procedures to administer the program including 18 rules-
- 19 establishing an application and review process and distribution of program scholarships. An
- 20 eligible student teacher may apply to the board to receive a scholarship under the 21 program.
- 22 To be eligible to receive a scholarship under this section, an individual: 3.
