- 3 Chairman Schaible and members of the Senate Education Committee. For the record my name is
- 4 Aimee Copas and I am here today representing NDCEL and all of our school leaders.
- 5 I will keep this brief. SB 2235 seems much like a replica of SB 2136 passed out of this committee
- 6 and out of the senate chamber recently with a unanimous do pass. This bill attempts to replicate
- 7 an amendment recently brought on the floor of the Senate that failed which removes the
- 8 requirement to attend a college with a physical presence in this state. One of the beautiful things
- 9 that our state scholarships does is keeps our students in the state of North Dakota thereby increasing
- 10 the odds that we will keep them in our workforce.
- NDCEL strongly recommends that we continue to keep our investment into our youth in-state.
- 12 This investment is also an investment in our North Dakota colleges and programs which keeps the
- dollars at home as well and is forward thinking investment in our economy.
- 14 Therefore, we respectfully recommend a do-not-pass on SB 2235.
