The Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation (RMEF) is a national hunting-based conservation organization with more than 4,100 members in North Dakota. RMEF and its partners have completed 235 conservation and hunting heritage outreach projects in the state with a combined value of more than \$11.9 million. These projects have protected or enhanced 59,016 acres of habitat and opened or improved public access to 36,317 acres.

RMEF supports HB 1162 and actions to modernize North Dakota's raffle laws. Improved technology provides safe and efficient tools for continuing charitable fundraising efforts beyond traditional methods.
