Good morning Chairman Vedaa and committee members.

For the record I am Jeff Magrum representing Dist. 28 in the State House. District 28 is south-central ND.

I stand before you to introduce HB1256. This bill is very simple and straight forward. The goal is a prohibition on state and political subdivisions from soliciting or accepting any grants or donations from private persons for elections operations or administration. This issue came to light after the 2020 election. Mark Zuckerberg's 501C3 organization granted over 400 million dollars to counties nationwide and to 42 counties in ND to be used for elections. This is alarming considering the potential for fraud in our elections. There are strings attached to the funds. Ironically there have been reports of suspected voter fraud in parts of the nation.

rk Zuckerberg's Facebook sells campaign advertising and controls the Algorithm (prioritization) of the adds creating potential for mischief as to who gets to see which advertising.

Elections are a sacred right in ND and should be protected. Our state is totally capable of conducting free and fair elections without giving up our sovereignty.

The House voted 78Yes-13N and I respectfully ask for a due pass recommendation.
