A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 19-02.1-16.5 of the North Dakota Century Code

- 2 relating to limitations on pharmacy benefits managers; to amend and reenact section
- 3 43-15-25.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to permitting pharmacists to administer
- 4 SARS-CoV-2 tests; to provide a penalty; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6	SEC	CTION 1. Section 19-02.1-16.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
7	enacted	as follows:
8	Pha	rmacy benefits managers - Prohibition on discrimination - Penalty.
9	1.	As used in this section:
10		a. "Pharmacy" means a pharmacy licensed under the laws of this state.
11		b. "Pharmacy benefits manager" has the same meaning as in section 19-03.6-01.
12	2.	A pharmacy benefits manager may not discriminate against or interfere with a covered
13		entity participating under section 340B of the federal Public Health Service Act
14		[42 U.S.C. 201 et seq.] or a pharmacy under contract with a covered entity under
15		section 340B of the federal Public Health Service Act to provide pharmacy services on
16		behalf of the covered entity. This includes, refusing to contract with a pharmacy.
17	3.	A pharmacy benefits manager may not modify, by contract, provider manual, or other
18		means, the definition of pharmacy as defined in this section, implement discriminating
19		pricing models, reimburse a lower dollar amount for a drug purchased under
20		340B than if the drug had been purchased outside 340B, or interfere with any
21		section 340B pharmacy service between the covered entity and the contracted
22		pharmacy.
23	4.	Contract and claim information between the covered entity and contracted pharmacy is confidential.
24	5.	A pharmacy benefits manager that violates this section is guilty of a class B
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1	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-15-25.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
2	amended and reenacted as follows:
3	43-15-25.3. Approved laboratory tests.
4	Approved laboratory tests are the following waived screening tests: glucose monitoring
5	devices (FDA cleared/home use) 9221, cholesterol 1020, HDL cholesterol 2550, triglyceride
6	6118, and glycosylated hemoglobin (Hgb A1C) 2204, and SARS-CoV-2. Additional tests may be
7	added to this list as jointly determined by the board and the North Dakota board of medicine.
8	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
