- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to certification of recovery residences.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 5 and enacted as follows:
- 6 Recovery residences Certification.
- 7 <u>1.</u> As used in this section, "recovery residence" means housing for individuals recovering
- 8 <u>from drug or alcohol addiction which provides a safe and supportive drug and</u>
- 9 <u>alcohol-free environment that may include peer support and other recovery support</u>
- 10 services.
- 11 <u>2.</u> The department shall establish and implement a voluntary certification program for
- 12 <u>recovery residences in the state.</u>
- 13 <u>3. In implementing this section, the department may:</u>
- 14 <u>a.</u> <u>Charge a fee for certification and recertification.</u>
- 15 <u>b.</u> <u>Adopt rules.</u>
- 16 <u>c.</u> <u>Contract with a third party.</u>
- d. Require an applicant to be certified by a third-party, such as the national alliance
- 18 <u>for recovery residences.</u>
