APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -7 **HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL STUDENT LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM.** There is 8 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise 9 appropriated, the sum of \$96,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the 10 department of health and human services for the purpose of funding four slots for public health

professionals and four slots for registered nurses under the health care professional student

loan repayment program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
