- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-27.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to restrictions on adult-oriented performances; to amend and reenact
- 3 section 12.1-27.1-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to state pre-emption of local
- 4 laws regulating obscenity; and to provide a penalty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-27.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 7 created and enacted as follows:

8 <u>Restrictions on adult-oriented performances - Penalty.</u>

- 9 <u>1.</u> As used in this section, "adult-oriented performance" means a performance that,
- 10 regardless of whether or not performed for consideration, is intended to appeal to a
- 11 prurient interest and features:
- 12 <u>a.</u> <u>The purposeful exposure, whether complete or partial, of:</u>
- 13 (1) <u>A human genital, the pubic region, the human buttocks, or a female breast,</u>
 14 if the breast is exposed below a point immediately above the top of the
 - <u>areola; or</u>

- (2) Prosthetic genitalia, breasts, or buttocks; or
- 17 <u>b.</u> <u>Sexual conduct.</u>
- 18 2. <u>A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor for a first offense and a class C felony for</u>
 19 <u>a second or subsequent offense if the person organizes an adult-oriented</u>
- 20 performance:
- 21 <u>a.</u> <u>On public property; or</u>
- 22 b. In a location where individuals under the age of eighteen are admitted or allowed.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-27.1-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is

2 amended and reenacted as follows:

3 **12.1-27.1-12.** State pre-emption of local laws regulating obscenity.

- 4 This chapter shall beis applicable and uniform throughout the state, and noa political
- 5 subdivision shallmay not enact new, or enforce existing, ordinances or resolutions regulating or
- 6 prohibiting the dissemination of obscene materials, or controlling obscene <u>or adult-oriented</u>
- 7 performances, except ordinances authorized by section 5-02-09, section 58-03-11, chapter
- 8 11-33, or chapter 40-47.
