- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 14-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to prohibiting governmental entities from interfering with parental rights.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 14-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows:
- 6 Interference with parental rights prohibition - Cause of action.
- 7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a governmental entity may not interfere 8 with the fundamental right of a parent to direct the upbringing, education, health care, 9 and mental health of the parent's child, unless the governmental entity demonstrates
- 10 the interference:
- 11 <u>a.</u> Furthers a compelling governmental interest; and
- 12 b. Is narrowly tailored and is the least restrictive means available to further the 13 compelling governmental interest.
- 14 <u>2.</u> If a parent's fundamental rights protected by this section are violated, a parent may 15 assert that violation as a claim or defense in a judicial proceeding and may obtain 16 appropriate relief against the governmental entity. The prevailing party in an action
- 17 filed pursuant to this section is entitled to reasonable attorney fees and costs.
